## **BEST VALUE STATEMENT**

The Management Committee and Senior Leadership Team (SLT) are accountable for the ways in which the Centre's resources are allocated to meet the objectives set out in the School Improvement Plan (SIP). The Management Committee will challenge and support the SLT to secure the best possible outcome for all students, in the most efficient and effective way, at a reasonable cost.

The Management Committee and Senior Leadership Team will apply the following principles of best value when making decisions about the targeting of resources in order to best promote the aims and values of the centre:

### **Challenge**

- The Centre's performance should be good or better in all areas.
- There should be a clear rationale for all services employed
- There should be a clear plan for all services employed
- There should be interrogation of continuation
- Services employed should address stakeholders' needs and views for performance.

### **Compare**

Aspects of the Centre's performance should be analysed alongside that of other centres in the Local Authority (LA).

### **Consult**

Plans for provision and improvement should draw on the views of stakeholders. This consultation process should be planned and clear.

### **Compete**

Services should be secured and employed by staff in a way that ensures maximum efficiency and effectiveness. There should be analysis of the comparative quality of services.

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
